Plantation of Anacardium Occidentale

A cashew tree or Anacardium Occidentale was planted at Christ College campus at the onset of the monsoon this July 2021. Cashew was planted with the objective of educating students about a unique plant which is rarely seen in a place like Bhopal.

A cashew tree is a tropical evergreen tree that produces the cashew seed and cashew apple. The tree can grow as high as 14 mts but the dwarf variety cultivators grow may reach upto 6 mts.

The cashew seed is primarily consumed as a snack nut, eaten on its own, used in recipes, processed into cashew cheese and cashew butter. The shell of the cashew seed yields derivatives that can be used in many applications including lubricants, water proofing, paints etc.

The cashew apple is a light reddish to yellow fruit, whose pulp and juice can be processed into a sweet, astringent fruit drink or fermented and distilled into liquor.

The campus is made greener and healthier year after year with varieties of exquisite and rare collections of annuals and perennials and the surrounding seasonal flower gardens. The sprawling orchard behind the college is a beautiful view to behold, with chikoos, mangoes, gooseberry, lichee, jackfruits, guavas, lemon, dragonfruit, avocado and many other shade trees along with the rich collection of medicinal plants in the herbal garden.



Campaign Against Hunger and Disease

The Lord said, "Love thy neighbour as thyself". Inspired by the teachings of Lord Jesus Christ, Christ College organized under the guidance of Rev. Fr. Dominic, Director, a campaign to help and support the needy from the neighbourhood. Being Eco Friendly Our Way

Towards our effort to inculcate eco-friendly behaviour, Rev. Fr Dominic, Director and Rev. Fr. Johnson, Principal distributed eco friendly pens on 15 August 2021. Researches tell that around 10 to 15 lakh plastic pens are thrown everyday in India itself creating environmental hazard. These eco friendly pens have been made from 100% recycled cardboard. This has reduced the use of plastic in the pens by 95%. Further these pens contain seeds of vegetables and flowers. After using the pen we need to push the pens into the soil in a pot, water it and place it in the sun. After 1 or 2 days remove the stub. The seeds germinate in 7-10 days. This is a small eco conscious venture in the green chapter of the Christ College. Dr. Pallavi explained to the audience of the Independence Day celebration, how to use these eco friendly pens and the seeds in them.

At present alarming growth of pollution, the build up of filth mountains, the deposit of tons of plastic in the ocean beds and the depleting forest cover will soon enlist the humans too among the highly endangered species on the earth. Man is the only animal that creates waste and all the more continues to be unresponsive and irresponsible to the imminent threat of self-extinction. Eco friendly living is the mantra of survival. The pristine nature is to be preserved at all times and by all means. The counter culture of abusing the eco system will certainly jeopardize the already delicate mantle of the biosphere. We need to educate the younger generation in safe guarding the sanctity of the whole nature.
