## About the seminar

The current National Education Policy of India 2020 (NEP 2020) outlines the new educational system's goals for both schools and higher education institutions. The Indian government has created the framework for transformational and dynamic transformation of our nation's higher education and education system. On July 29, 2020, the Indian Union Cabinet adopted the National Education Policy 2020. The former "National Policy on Education, 1986" has been superseded by the new one.

The former Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD) has been renamed the Ministry of Education (MOE), as recommended by the NEP 2020, as part of our nation's first education policy of the twenty-first century, which replaced the national education policy that had been in effect for 34 years.

The four pillars of the new NEP 2020 are access, equality, quality, and accountability. One of the key decisions made as part of NEP 2020 is the replacement of the old 10+2 structure with a 5+3+3+4 schooling structure that places an emphasis on the first five years of early childhood care and education beginning at age three and consists of 12 years of school and 3 years of preschool or anganwadi.

It also places a strong emphasis on using native or regional languages as the medium of teaching up until Class 5 and seeks to quickly raise state spending on education from around 3% to 6% of the GDP. It suggests a four-year multidisciplinary bachelor's degree in an undergraduate programme with a variety of exit choices for further education, and it calls for the establishment of the Higher Education Commission of India (HECI) to oversee higher education.

The purpose of this national seminar is to exchange information and engage in discussion on how to properly implement NEP 2020 at educational institutions all throughout India. The seminar's conclusion would help its planners, attendees, and other stakeholders in coming up with ideas and legislative and policy-based initiatives to make changes.
