2. Title of the Practice: Certificate course in Research Methodology

Content

Research Cell of Christ College Bhopal organized a 10 days online Certificate course on Research Methodology for M.Ed. Sem-1 and M.Ed. Sem-3 Students from 6 November to 21 November 2020. The workshop was divided into two phases, phase-I from 6 November to 11 November and Phase-II from 18 th to 21 st November.
