### Code of Conduct for Students

- It is compulsory for all to submit their vaccination certificate at the college office.

- > Students must help keep the institute neat and clean and also preserve and maintain the greeneries. Eatables are not allowed inside the study areas including labs, library, workshops.
- > Students must conserve electricity and water. They must switch off lights & fans when they leave the class room, laboratories.
- > Dress up in a manner that is appropriate for academic environment.
- Interact with all members of college community with politeness and courtesy.
- Respect differences in relation to gender, race, nationality, disability and religion.
- ➤ Be ambassadors of college in local area, extend respect to all members of local community.
- User facilities like books, equipments and resources provided to assist you in a careful and responsible manner.
- Alert the college security staff if you are aware of any potential risk to yourself or others.
- > Avoid disposing litter inappropriately in college campus.
- > Don't be in possession of any bladed article or offensive weapon or firearms.
- > Don't be in possession of drugs, alcoholic beverages or intoxicants.
- > Gambling and smoking is prohibited inside college campus.
- Don't engage in any violent or threatening behavior. Avoid intimidation, verbal slurs, insults or taunts, ridicule which may disrupt educational environment.
- Don't behave in such a manner within or outside the college that may bring disrepute to college.
- Maintain academic integrity by not cheating or using unfair means during exams.
- Fire crackers and explosives are prohibited on campus.
- Conduct which infringes upon freedom or activities of others constitutes disorderly behavior.

- Parking of vehicles in no parking zones or in area earmarked for other persons is not allowed.
- > Students are expected not to interact on behalf of institute with media representatives or invite media persons on campus without permission of authorities.
- The students must maintain satisfactory standard of academic performance. They must be committed to studies, attend classes regularly, participate actively and constructively in all the classrooms activities and complete all tasks allocated to them.

### Penalties for minor disciplinary violation

Where the violation is considered minor by the Competent Authority, the following penalties may be imposed at the discretion of the Competent Authority for minor disciplinary violations:

- A warning to be issued to the student for first offence may not be placed in the students record. However, in case of a repeat offence the censure may be placed on the students record and may invite action;
- A fine may be imposed for each violation / offence;
- Withholding scholarship or other benefits/ grade cards / offer letters

#### Penalties for ragging

As per Supreme Court Judgment ragging is - any disorderly conduct whether by words spoken or written or by an act with the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness any other student, Indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in a fresher or a junior student or asking the students to do any act or perform something which such student will not do in the ordinary course and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of a fresher or a junior student.

The punishment may also take the shape of:

- withholding scholarships or other benefits
- debarring from representation in events
- withhold results
- suspend or expel from hostel or institute
